### A REGION FULLY MOBILISED AGAINST THE CRISIS

### **AN AGILE AND RESPONSIVE INSTITUTION**

- Continuity of public service from the very beginning of the crisis, with almost 100% of employees in work from home
- Direct purchase of 30 Mn masks for Ile-de-France residents
- Creation of an information platform Info Covid-19 30 000 calls/requests handled
- Reduction of payment times. Expenses related to Covid-19 paid in 48h
- Supply of a centralized purchasing platform (for masks, hydro-alcoholic gel, etc.)
   More than 10 000 purchasers (private and public)

### A MASSIVE AND UNIQUE RECOVERY PLAN...

- A €1,3 Bn recovery plan
- €709 Mn of redeployed commitments and €592 Mn of new commitments voted in the 2020 Supplementary Budget.
- Acceleration of the digital transition, support to SMEs and new measures to finance the conversion of their production chain, support for healthcare professionals, emergency funds for the performing arts sector ...

## AN AMBITIOUS COVID-19 RECOVERY PLAN, IN 2 STEPS

Region Ile-de-France is fully mobilised in the fight against Covid-19 and its economic and social consequences, and will deploy an ambitious recovery plan in 2 steps:

• Step I - Emergency support investments, for €1.3 Bn (as per the Supplementary Budget voted on June 11, 2020),

# A MODIFIED FRAMEWORK TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT SOME MEASURES OF THE RECOVERY PLAN

The framework used by Region Ile-de-France for the support measures for SMEs on the Region's its green and sustainable bond issues has been slightly modified to ensure the eligibility of the sanitary measures taken during the fight against the Covid-19. The existing framework already covered the projects in favor of employment, and
